<b>Overview</b>	The Scholarship aims to assist outstanding but disadvantaged students, from a rural or regional area, that have been offered a full-time place at an Australian university or college for the first time.
<b>Faculty</b>	All
<b>Study area</b>	All
<b>Scholarship type</b>	Need based, Merit based
<b>Year of study</b>	First year undergraduate
<b>Duration</b>	1 year initially but may be awarded for up to 2 years (dependent upon academic performance)
<b>Intention of Scholarship</b>	Accommodation costs
<b>Award Value (per student)</b>	Award values remain at the discretion of the special Committee. Award value is approximately \$5,000 (per annum) based on previous years
<b>Eligibility</b>	Students must be a first-time first year undergraduate in 2012 studying a full-time degree at an Australian university or college. All study must take place within Australia. The student must be from a rural or regional location and be academically gifted.
<b>Nationality</b>	Australian citizen or permanent resident
<b>Opening Date</b>	9.30am (AEDST) on 1 December 2011
<b>Closing Date</b>	5pm (AEDST) on 27 January 2012
<b>Application Process</b>	Applications are invited from 1 December 2011. Please visit <a href="http://www.bendigoadelaide.com.au">www.bendigoadelaide.com.au</a> for more information from this date
<b>Criteria</b>	Scholarships will be awarded on the recommendation of a selection committee and will be based on how an applicant addresses the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Academic achievement</li> <li>• Demonstrated disadvantage - financial and / or social</li> <li>• Evidence of leadership and citizenship within their communities</li> </ul>
