ABED Course Map Accelerated Program Year 3 and 4

Students in the Bachelor of Education Accelerated Program receive two years' credit (168 credit points). This program requires students to have completed at least two years of full time higher education study that cover the Elective General Study component of the Bachelor of Education. These units will usually constitute two teaching discipline/method sequences as described in the Victorian Institute of Teaching 'Specialist Area Guidelines'.

To complete the course, students in the Accelerated Program will complete 17 core education units.

Note that students will be enrolled in more than a full time load in Year 3 to ensure they meet registration requirements for the Victorian Institute of Teaching
