The Master of Education is a flexible coursework program, offering the opportunity to exit at the **Graduate Certificate in Educational Learning and Leadership** or the **Graduate Diploma in Educational Learning and Leadership**.

It is designed to meet the needs of professionals whose work has an educational component or some educational responsibility.

Classes reflect the latest theory and research in education. You will be taught by interesting educators who are active researchers, have extensive experience in their fields and will support, encourage and extend your learning.

A total of **SIX** units must be completed to gain a Master of Education qualification. These units are all offered during the evening or in 'burst' mode over a series of weekends. We also offer summer and winter units.

How long does it take?

Most people complete two units per year, though some take winter and summer school options for quicker progress

Straight from the B.Ed or Dip Ed?

Yes, there has been an increasing trend for people to move straight from pre-service teacher-education into the M.Ed. This means that your study skills don't become rusty!

Structure of the M.Ed

- Education Research Design and Methods [AED5001] - Compulsory Core Research unit

- Two Core Units chosen from:

Curriculum [AED5007], Approaches to Learning [AED5011], Innovation [AED5009], Educational Leadership [AED5012]

- Electives selected from specified list.

Students enrolling in the M.Ed are strongly encouraged to enrol in core units for at least three of their first four units. Of these, one unit must be the compulsory core unit, AED5001 Education Research Design and Methods. Students may then choose to complete the M.Ed via the minor thesis option or by completing two further coursework units.

A Minor Thesis option (equivalent to two units of study) is available when students have successfully completed four units, three of which must be core.
