

UMAP and Endeavour Scholarship Selection Criteria

Requirements:

Academic average of at least 65%

A strong personal statement, references and C.V.

How to apply

On the Victoria Abroad Application for Outgoing VU students form please tick 'UMAP' or 'Endeavour' in Section 4 under the heading 'Type of Exchange'.

Please note: If you are not successful in your application for a scholarship you will be granted a VU Travel Grant (where eligible).

Selection criteria

1) Academic Grades

2) Personal Statement.

Your personal statement should be no more than 1 page and should include the following:

- Information about yourself which supports your application.
- Why you have chosen the country you wish to study in.
- Why you have chosen the particular University.
- What you think you will achieve personally, academically and professionally from the exchange.
- What you will do with the knowledge and experience gained from the program on your return.
- Any extra curricular activities you are involved in which you feel support your application (for example community involvement, memberships of sporting or community clubs and associations).
- Why you think you would be a good ambassador for Victoria University.

3) Academic reference.

Your referee's recommendation on your suitability for exchange and academic performance will be considered.

4) C.V.

Your C.V. (or resume) should outline your academic and work history up to the present day. It should list all of your achievements such as awards or scholarships. It should also detail any professional, community and sporting teams or memberships which you are a part of.
