If you are applying for a Graduate Program in Counselling or Psychology, you must read this Advice to Applicants before you complete your application.

All external applicants for Graduate Programs in Counselling and Psychology (excluding AGPP Graduate Diploma in Psychological Studies) must supply an Academic and/or Professional Reference as part of their application.

All internal course applicants (currently enrolled Victoria University students) applying for Graduate or Honours programs, will need to submit at least one Academic Referee Report including referee name and contact details with their application form.
