

## Scholarships to Victoria University transcript

We offer equity and achievement scholarships to help students in their undergraduate and TAFE studies to support them through their studies.

We have equity scholarships which are to provide financial support to students doing undergraduate courses. And we also have achievement scholarships which are for students who have performed well in year 12 and been ranked by their school as the highest performing student.

It's a fairly simple process to apply for an equity scholarship at Victoria University.

It's all done in electronic form through VTAC and you do it at the same time as you apply for a VTAC course. So, when you're in the VTAC system you do your online course application and you can also do an online scholarship application either at the same time or before or after.

It doesn't cost you anything to do a scholarship application through VTAC. And a lot of answers you provide in your course application will be used in your scholarship application.

To apply for an achievement scholarship with Victoria University the best way to start is to contact the Careers Coordinator at your school. If you're studying at one of the schools in the western suburbs of Melbourne we ask that you register your interest and then the school will rank you according to your performance in year 12.

If you're ranked as the highest performing student then you'll be offered a scholarship to come and study at Victoria University in either higher education or TAFE studies.

If you're wishing to do a TAFE course with us then you can apply for a scholarship while you're studying with us. We usually have an application round in the middle of the year. So it's just a matter of keeping your eye on our website so you know when to apply.

One of the really important messages about scholarships is that Centrelink provide Commonwealth scholarships to students who are on Youth Allowance or Austudy. And so it's really important that you do check your eligibility because if you're entitled to Austudy or Youth Allowance you also get a Commonwealth scholarship which is worth quite a bit of money, so it's definitely worth enquiring.
