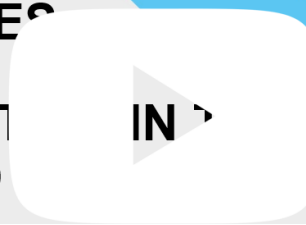
Dear Career Practitioner,
