Drawn on the scholarly literature on teaching and learning to inform the development of initiatives, programs and/or practice.

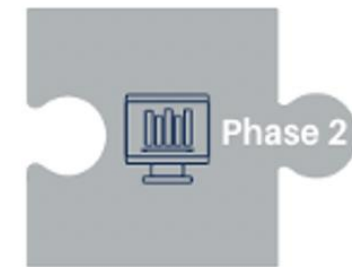

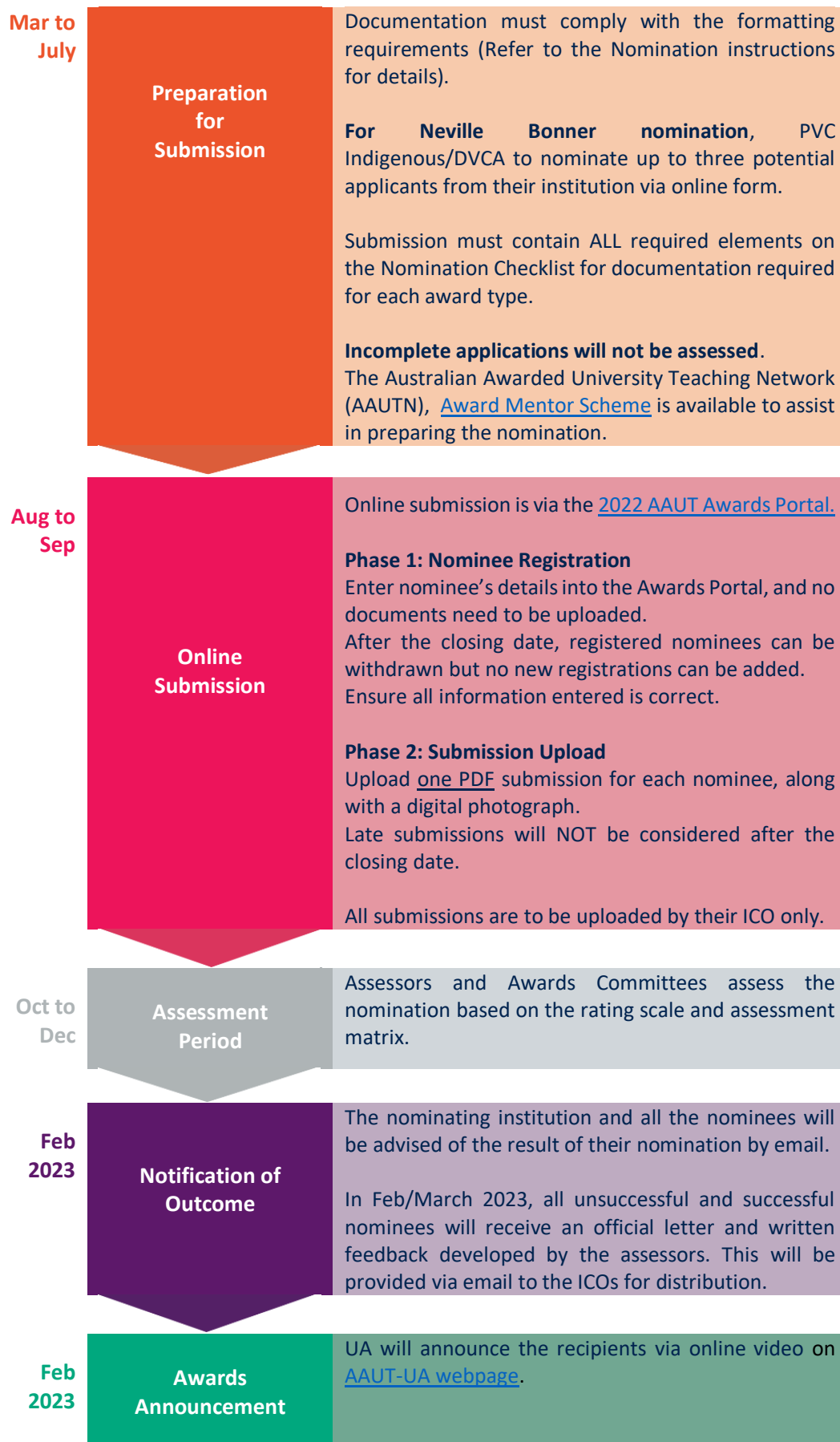
