 - Innovation = Science, R&D, technology and commercialisation

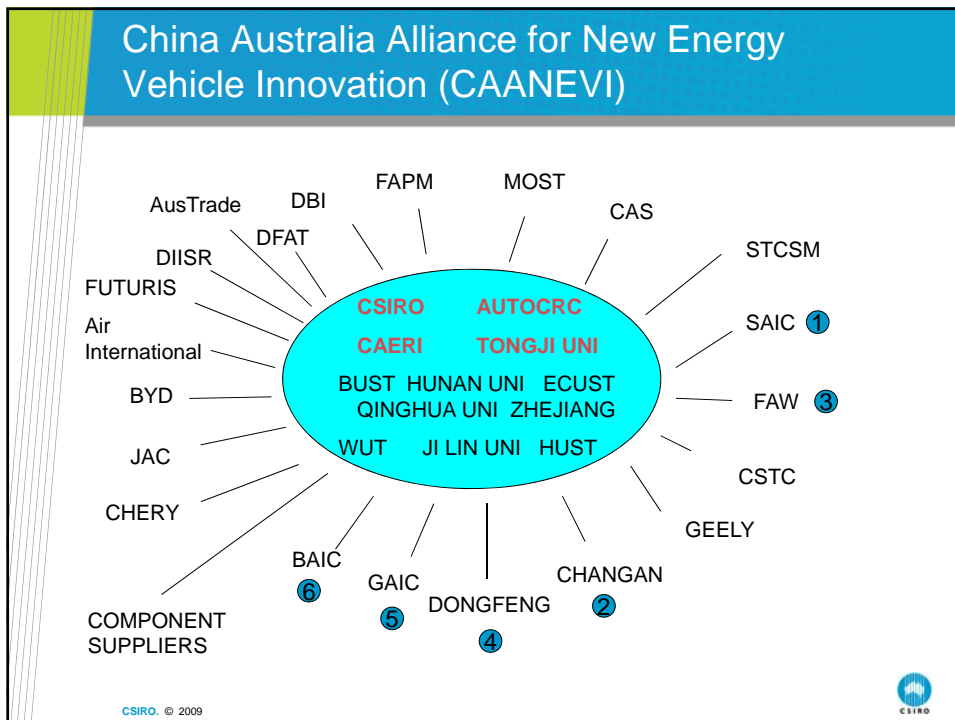

History

- Chinese and Australian governments committed to lower fuel consumption, lower emission vehicle technologies.
- Australian Government MoUs with Anhui/Hubei municipalities following a visit to Australia by Vice Minister of MOST, Prof. Cao Jianlin, and China visit of Ministers Carr and Crean.
- AIIC, Auto CRC, DIISR, DFAT, DBI, CSIRO have aligned automotive engagement strategies for China
- Development of automotive research alliance with key players in government, industry and research
- At World Expo in Shanghai, CSIRO initiated round table discussion with key players: Alliance formed in principle.
