About the Victoria University (VU) Alumni Awards

VU takes great pride in the achievements and successes of our Alumni. VU Alumni reflect our values and help create our legacy. The Alumni Awards program raises awareness of our global community of over 230,000 Alumni and honours their outstanding contributions to our University, to Melbourne's West, across Australia and in the international arena. Since their inauguration in 2011, nominees for the Awards have included people from a diverse range of professions, industries and educational backgrounds. All have made themselves and VU proud of their endeavours and achievements.

This is your chance to be involved as a nominator or nominee (or both). We seek your involvement in identifying a great colleague, friend or family member who is studying at VU; and be a part of the celebration to recognise the difference the VU student and Alumni Community makes to our society.

The Outstanding Student - Future Alumni Award

This award recognises a current student who has demonstrated outstanding qualities in leadership and the ability to inspire other students. They have excelled in their academic pursuit, business initiatives, and /or their volunteer or community related work.

Important Information – please read before you proceed with a nomination

Guidelines / conditions of nomination

- 1. Please follow the nomination process for the selected Award. Each nomination form lists the criteria for that Award. The selection panel will rank nominees based on:
 - a. Conformance with the eligibility criteria such as age, being a student or Alumni
 - b. Demonstration of how the nominee clearly meets the Award category criteria
 - c. Conformance with **requirements** including sign off by nominator that the nominee has accepted the nomination, listing and contact details for 2 referees
 - d. Any other information provided in support of the nomination
- 2. Nominations that do not meet the eligibility and requirements criteria; or that are not received by the closing date may not be assessed by the Awards Selection Panel.
- 3. If a nomination does not clearly show how the nominee meets the Award criteria; it is very difficult for the selection panel to assess this nominee. The panel will not search for further information about the nominee it will only review what is on the nomination form. Nominators are encouraged to work with their nominee to make sure they put forward all information that will support the nominee (within designated word limits be focused and clear). This is not a time for modesty be clear about the nominee's achievements.
- 4. There will only be one (1) recipient in each Award category each year.
- 5. Individuals may only be nominated in one category in each year.
- 6. Past nominees are eligible for nomination in any category.
- 7. Self-nomination is acceptable. The nomination must still include 2 referees.
- 8. Nominators should consider asking the nominee for the names and contact details of the referees, to help ensure that the people nominated as referees have the desired level of knowledge of the work and achievements of the nominee; and have agreed to be available if required, at the times noted in the nomination pack.
- 9. A nomination is not a guarantee of selection for an Award. The Selection Panel may choose not to make a recommendation for Award in any category.
- 10. All recommendations made by the Selection Panel and endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor are final.
- 11. In giving acceptance / permission for the nomination, the nominee agrees that their image and other information (excluding any personal contact details) will be used to assist the Alumni Relations Team to promote the nominee, VU and the Alumni Awards; and that they will assist the Alumni Relations Team with this promotion and associated activities as reasonably requested. It is the responsibility of the nominator to ensure this is understood by the nominee.

Process for submitting nominations

- 1. Download and save the relevant PDF nomination pack; complete the PDF form within the pack (you can save as you go).
- 2. Alternatively, you can download, print and fill in the form by hand; scan the completed form.
- 3. Email <u>alumni@vu.edu.au</u> with 'Outstanding Student Future Alumni Award nomination nominee name' in the email title. Please do not forget to attach the completed nomination pack and the nominee's resume.

Specific Information

Who can be nominated?

Nominations are encouraged from all people who meet the eligibility and selection criteria, regardless of field of study, current role or industry, or current geographic location. VU is committed to gender equality and strongly encourages the nomination of women as they are traditionally under-represented in Award programs.

Who can make a nomination?

Any member of the VU community including Alumni, staff, students, industry partners, community partners and friends of VU may nominate an individual for a VU Alumni Award

How are the nominations assessed?

An Awards Selection Panel will be assembled with members from the University and Alumni Community. Selection will be based on assessment against the eligibility criteria, requirements and Award category selection criteria. The Panel will make recommendations to the Vice-Chancellor for endorsement.

In recognition that an overwhelming number of VU Alumni and students have faced adversity at some stage, the Panel has discretion to recommend to the Vice-Chancellor a recipient for one (1) "Spirit of Victoria University Award" each year; to a nominee who is not recommended as the recipient in their Award category; yet impresses the panel with the manner in which they have overcome significant challenges in their life and fully embodies the VU ethos. This would only occur in exceptional circumstances. People cannot be directly nominated for this Award as it is not a separate category, and is not automatically awarded each year.

Eligibility Criteria

1. The nominee must be enrolled as a VU student for all or part of 2017.

Award Category Criteria

- 1. Nominee has displayed outstanding student leadership and the ability to inspire other students.
- 2. Nominee has excelled in one or more of the following areas:
 - a. their business initiatives,
 - b. their volunteer or community related work
 - c. their extracurricular pursuits
 - d. their academic success
- 3. Nominee has demonstrated the values of integrity, respect and excellence in their activities and conduct.

Other Requirements

- 1. Nominee must agree to be nominated (see end of form)
- 2. Two referees must be provided; these can be professional or academic referees.

Other information

- 1. This Award will be made to no more than one recipient each year.
- 2. Nominations should demonstrate what the nominee does to go "above and beyond" the requirements of their course work.
