The Industry

Transport, Logistics and Supply Chain is a large and diverse industry with a wide range of functions from ordering, transporting, receiving, storing and distributing merchandise within Australia and overseas to planning, arranging, controlling and tracking the movement of goods for customers.

A 'supply chain' is the system of organisations, people, technology, activities, information and resources involved in moving a good or service from a supplier to their customer.

Careers in Transport, Logistics and Supply Chain

Every organisation is dependent on logistics and supply chain to function. Hospitals, restaurants, manufacturers, tourist operators, banks, mining companies and farms all need to use logistics expertise and services in their day to day functioning. Careers in transport, logistics and supply chain can be found not only within businesses that deliver traditional services such as transport, distribution, freight forwarding, customs brokering, warehousing, rail, aviation and stevedoring, but can also be found within companies such as manufacturers, exporters, importers, wholesalers and retailers. As you can see there are many exciting opportunities in transport, logistics and supply chain and this Career Map is designed to give you a quick snapshot into the types of careers, qualifications and salaries that you can expect.
