<b>COURSE REQUIREMENTS</b>	<p>To attain the Bachelor of Psychology (Honours) students will be required to complete 384 credit points, consisting of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 96 credit points (equivalent to 8 units) of Core First Year studies;</li><li>• 216 credit points (equivalent to 18 units) of Core Psychology studies;</li><li>• 2 x 24 credit points (equivalent to 2 units) of Core Thesis studies; and</li><li>• 24 credit points (equivalent to 2 units) of Psychology Elective studies.</li></ul> <p>In order to be eligible to advance to the fourth (Honours) year of the course, students must achieve the stringent academic admission criteria that are required for Honours programs in Psychology. Academic admission standards are based on the average grade across all core second and third year psychology units.</p> <p>Students who have successfully completed the first three years of study but have not met the academic admission requirements for the Honours year will be eligible to apply to graduate with a Bachelor of Psychological Studies.</p>
