- TABmate; autocreate CMF files, Run CMF button
- Parameters in CMF files
- RunDynam; make policy the base, running simulations from batch scripts
- Report generation and post-processing solutions SLTOHT, postsim statements, special report variables, for both comparative static and recursive dynamic models
- Condensation; tuning a model for faster runtimes
- Singular matrix problem
- Arithmetic error problems
