The Job

A suitably qualified person with experience in the use of animals in scientific or teaching activities

1. Duties

- Contribute to Committee discussions and discussions so that only work which satisfies the requirements of the Australian code of practice for the care and use of animals for scientific purposes (NHMRC) is approved
- Review Committee papers prior to each meeting and from time to time review out-of-session applications
- Attend each meeting (normally six per year)
- Provide advice and feedback to reflect researcher's point of view to the AEEC

2. Selection Criteria

Essential

- Must be a suitably qualified person with substantial recent experience in the use of animals in scientific or teaching activities
- Should possess a PhD qualifications
