1. Duties

- Contribute to Committee discussions and discussions so that only work
 which satisfies the requirements of the Australian code of practice for the
 care and use of animals for scientific purposes (NHMRC) is approved
- Review Committee papers prior to each meeting and from time to time review out-of-session applications
- Attend each meeting (normally six per year)
- Provide advice and feedback to reflect an animal welfare person's point of view to the AEEC

2. Selection Criteria

Essential

- Must be independent of Victoria University
- Must not be involved in the care and use of animals for scientific purposes

Desirable

 May be a veterinarian with specific animal welfare interest and experience (must provide evidence of welfare credentials and familiarity with current concerns with animal welfare community)
