

# Master of Clinical Exercise Science and Rehabilitation

## Course Requirements

To attain the Master of Clinical Exercise Science and Rehabilitation, students will be required to complete 144 credit points consisting of:

- 120 credit points of Core units
- 24 credit points of either:
  - Option 1: Additional Coursework Units
    - 12 credit points from SCL6004 Pain Science
    - 12 credit points from SCL7005 Complex Cases in Clinical Exercise Physiology
  - OR
  - Option 2: Thesis
    - 24 credit points from SCL7001 Minor Thesis

Students are required to enrol in all units for semester 1 and 2, and are not permitted to enrol in more than 48 credit points per semester as a full-time load.

## Credit Points

A credit point is used to measure the study load for a unit. A standard unit consists of 12 credit points, with each completed unit's credit points adding up to meet your required total of credit points to complete your course.
