

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Growth in low and high skill services, share of value added





Components of India and China's services imports, US\$ billion



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
Top five Victorian services exports by value, 2002 to 2012, \$ million


Victorian universities HE offshore student revenues, \$m

Why isn't Victoria doing better? Results of interviews with professional services firms

- A high proportion of professional services exports with Asia (especially China) are generated by FDI proposals in the resource and property areas where local expertise is essential
- US firms are able to assemble large teams that more easily amortise fixed costs
- Foreign firms are not so willing to pay the premium for Australian expertise in their home markets an 'Asian centric' bias
- Cultural and regulatory issues FTA with China

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
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Global services* imports, countries ranked by share, 2001 and 2011






Value of US exports of Other private services to selected Asian countries, 2011, US\$ billion
