Individual Learning Plans

Over 1200 young students undertook an ILP in 2011

- 45.7% had attended 3 or more secondary schools
- 35.7% received some form of government welfare payments
- 11.4% were engaged with an external youth worker or counsellor
- 52.8% were living with only one birth parent or less
- 55.7% said they had below average literacy/numeracy skills
- 24.2% were not happy with their appearance or had self-esteem or confidence issues
- 8.5% chose their course because they were having trouble at their previous school.
