

40RTYK GLOBE – VU INTERNSHIP SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Background on the program

[40K Globe](http://40k.com.au) offers one month internship opportunities for students in the June/July and November to February periods. The 40K Globe program is a unique social business internship where students are trained in Australia on the principles of social enterprise, then travel to India for a 1 month practicum to work on building social businesses that solve problems for rural Indian communities. The internships are diverse and have wide application from business, to the arts, and international development. 40K is currently working with nine Universities across Australia including the University of Sydney, UNSW, Deakin University, UTS, UniSA and Monash University. 40K recently won a national social enterprise award and is at the forefront of this emerging field in Australia.

Internship Scholarship Opportunity

We are offering the opportunity for two VU students to participate in the January OR February 2015 program in India and carry out a marketing internship for 40K Globe and VU. 40K will cover the costs of the 1 month social internship program in India (AU\$2,200) and VU will provide a \$1,000 travel grant. The internship component is unpaid. The student will be required to complete a Marketing Internship for one semester at VU to promote the 40K Globe program to other students at VU. This would include activities such as presenting in lectures, hanging posters around the university, assisting at recruitment events and maintaining a blog and social media posts.

The program lends itself naturally to those involved in business, international studies, communication, media and community development.

- 2) You will receive a reference from 40K General Manager letter asserting your involvement in the internship.
