





A creative response to student needs



Eight units: Literacy Numeracy, STEM, Academic and Professional Learning (taught with an Arts Pedagogy), Health and PE, Sociology, Humanities (through an indigenous Australian lens), ICT

Extra hours in units to provide added learning support; creative pedagogy

Pathways into: Year 2 of the B.Ed (P-12) (students must have a 70% average across the EDES, and meet LANTITE and CASPer.

Pathways into Year 2 of B. Ed Studies and B.Early Childhood education

Great student satisfaction ratings; wonderful entry to HE

Bachelor of Early Childhood Education

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Space and place



Engagement with young children in natural environments; play-based explorations centred on an understanding of belonging in the world

0 – 5 years – child-care and Kinder qualified

Double the present number of EC Educators will be required in the next 5 – 10 years

Can pathway into a M.Teach (primary)

Placement in playgroups, childcare centres, long day care and kindergartens

Three years; LANTITE not required

Bachelor of Education P-12

The B Ed P-12 consists of:

- ◆ **Four years of full time study**
 - ◆ Core education units for primary and secondary
 - ◆ Secondary specialisation units
- ◆ **Professional experience in both primary and secondary schools (over 100 days in schools)**
- ◆ **Opportunities to participate in overseas study tours and teach in other countries.**





Literacy and Numeracy Test Initial Teacher Education

B.Ed P-12

Needs to be completed in the First Year of the degree.

All student will meet the bench mark for Long term Partnership Placements.

Students on a pathway into Year 2 need to have LANTITE before they can move across

IELTS REQUIREMENTS

International English Language Testing System (IELTS)

Academic: Overall 7.5 with the following required in each of the skill areas:

- ◆ *speaking 8.0*
- ◆ *listening 8.0*
- ◆ *reading 7.0*
- ◆ *writing 7.0*

IELTS not required for EDES (pathway course)

LANTITE (Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education)

Compulsory

- ◆ External requirement set by the Victorian Government
- ◆ Top 30% of the population for literacy and numeracy
- ◆ Must be done towards the end of Year 1 and before the start of Year 2 practicum
- ◆ There is a cost involved


