

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR THE VU WOMEN IN SPORT SCHOLARSHIP

These Guidelines apply to holders of:

The VU Women in Sport Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, students must be:

- An Australian citizen or permanent resident
- Be enrolled at VU in an undergraduate or postgraduate study in sport
- Reside in Australia
- Have experienced barriers and challenges in their academic and personal life that have prevented them from accessing/completing tertiary study
- Be able to clearly articulate their career aspirations in sport

CONDITIONS OF AWARD TO SCHOLARS

Recipients:

- Must remain enrolled full-time in an undergraduate or postgraduate degree at Victoria University;
- May not transfer the Scholarship to study at another institution;
- May not hold the Scholarship in addition to another Victoria University scholarship;
- Must notify the Scholarships Office immediately if they:
 - Discontinue or intermit full-time study;
 - Transfer to another institute; or
 - Transfer to another program within the University;
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress, according to the University's Student Progress Policy.
- Must notify the Scholarships office if they accept a University sanctioned international exchange to allow the continuation of the Scholarship; and
- Will seek independent advice from the relevant authorities on the effect, if any, that the Scholarship may have on eligibility for Government benefits or any taxation implications.
- Agree for VU to provide their name to the donor upon accepting the scholarship.
