

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR VICTORIA UNIVERSITY ASYLUM SEEKER SCHOLARSHIPS

These Guidelines apply to holders of:

Victoria University Asylum Seeker Scholarship

1 CONDITIONS OF AWARD TO SCHOLARS

Must be:

- An Asylum Seeker holding a Bridging Visa, Temporary Protection Visa or Safe Haven Enterprise Visa;
- Have completed a TAFE course at Victoria University Polytechnic;
- Be nominated by the appropriate representative from Victoria University Polytechnic;
- Meet course admission criteria; and
- Meet all eligibility guidelines at census date (24/03/2021).

2 ONGOING ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

- Enrolled in a full-time undergraduate degree at Victoria University;
- May not transfer the Scholarship to study in a different course or at another institution;
- Must notify the Scholarships Office immediately if you:
 - Discontinue full-time study;
 - Transfer to another institute; or
 - Transfer to another course within the University.
- Will maintain a GPA of 3.5 or higher out of 7 in accordance with the University's Academic Progress policies (<https://www.vu.edu.au/current-students/your-course/enrolment/student-attendance-progress>).
- Must notify the Scholarships Office if they accept a University sanctioned international exchange to allow the continuation of the Scholarship.
- Comply with University standards with regard to academic misconduct

If the above conditions are not met, the scholarships office may discontinue your scholarship.

3 VALUE AND DURATION

- \$5,000 per year for the duration of the selected undergraduate degree, accounting for pathway credit.
- Course tuition fees will be sponsored by Victoria University for the duration of the scholarship.
